FAMIS: Covering Children With Affordable Health Insurance

FAMIS

Did You Know?

Lawful permanent resident (LPR), conditional entrant, and parolee children who entered the U.S. on or after August 22, 1996 are eligible *after* the first 5 years of residence in the U.S.



Most LPR, conditional entrant, and parolee children who entered the U.S. before August 22, 1996 are eligible for **FAMIS**.

The immigrants listed below are usually eligible, regardless of how long they have lived in the U.S.:

Refugees and Amerasians

Cuban or Haitian entrants

Asylees

Deportees (if deportation is withheld).

FAMIS Plus (Medicaid)

Did You Know?

Children who entered the U.S. on or after or before August 22, 1996 may be eligible, *depending* on their immigration status.

Children with visas or undocumented children, and some immigrant children, may be eligible for emergency medical services *only*.

What Information Do I Need to Apply?

1. Proof of income (if paid in cash, a statement from your employer can be used).
2. The child's alien number and a copy of child's alien card or immigration papers.
3. The child's social security number (SSN) or application for an SSN (**FAMIS Plus only**).
